The amphitheater El Jem is one of the most emblematic architectural contributions of ancient Rome.



PLACES TO VISIT

Mahdia is a city with many architectural masterpieces thanks to its rich past. There is the fortified gate of Skifa Kahla, the old port, the big Bordj El Kebir and the museum of Mahdia. It is also known by the Great Mosque, the old ramparts, the marine cemetery and the amphitheater El Jem.



SKIFA EL KAHLA

Skifa El Kahla is a huge gate dating back to the beginning of the 10th century. It is still one of the access points to the historic center of the city of Mahdia and one of the few remains of the old city walls, located in the center of the ancient citadel. The Skifa is part of the system of ramparts rebuilt by the Turks at the end of the 16th century. Fortified city gate, Skifa el Kahla was the main tower of the 2nd line of defense to block access to the city.
