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PREFACE

Kounouz Ennajeh is a new practice book series that targets all subjects in Basic as well as in Secondary Education. Each book is made up of four sections:

1- The first section includes:

- A full explanation of grammatical rules and structures supported with examples.
- Graded exercises and tasks for reinforcement and consolidation.
- Multiple choice exercises to check pupil's understanding.

2- Second section includes:

- Tests that help: They help the learner to check his/her acquired knowledge, skills and abilities to get ready for his/her exams.

3- Third section includes:

- Key to the pupil's book exercises and tasks.

4- Fourth section includes:

- Key to the exercises in the first section.
- Key to multiple choice exercises.
- Key to the tests.

The new official programme (September 2004) has given an important role to the parents and considered them as "school partners" and assigned them the duty of tutoring their children and encouraging them to overcome any difficulties they might encounter. There is no doubt that every parent wants to aid his/her child with his/her studies. However, their lack of knowledge in the subjects, among other reasons, doesn't help them much in their mission.

Although other practice books have helped parents to tutor their children by providing them with keys, they haven't helped them improve their children's level of attainment for the reasons already mentioned. Therefore, we have included detailed explanations of targeted grammatical points and structures. We have also included a key to the pupil's book exercises and tasks because they may not be all corrected at school. Thus, our main concern is to provide parents with a book that provides them with the necessary tools to assist their children in their studies. Teachers may also draw advantage of this series since it spares them the energy of preparing explanations and practice exercises.

It is worth mentioning that it is the parents' responsibility to help their children improve their level of attainment. Our objectives in helping them in this effort are:

- Providing them with appropriate tools to assist their children.
- Cultivate independence and responsibility in the learners who are required to resort to the key section to check his/her answers only.

To draw the best of this book we suggest the following procedure:

1- Learners are asked to do the exercises in this book as a follow up to school lessons.

2- Learners are asked to do the exercises on their own bearing in mind what they have learnt at school.

3- Parents are expected to help their children only when they face a difficulty by

- Explaining to them the targeted concepts after consulting the explanation section.
- Consulting the key sections whether to confirm or to correct the learner's answers.

As to the tests, they should be done only as a preparation to the school exam. They help the learner to check his knowledge, skills and abilities and take the school exam with confidence.

To conclude, this book is an effort to help learners to improve their level of attainment in English by engaging them in fun and motivating exercises and activities. It is also an effort to support parents who are willing to help their children with a clear process of language teaching.
